

**Addendum to RFP – Q&A
Pavement Management Program Update and GIS Linkage Update in Mendocino County
September 20, 2016**

Q1. What is name of consultant of last project in 2012/13?

A1. NCE conducted the last update.

Q2. Is the City of Point Arena miles (4 Miles) and sections included in the County Database at 684 miles(1,415 Sections)?

A2. Yes.

Q3. Can we have information of each agency as followings?

A3. This information is contained in the reports from the last Pavement Management Update conducted in FY 12/13. The reports can be found on the MCOG website, using the following link, then scrolling down on the page to the “Pavement Management Program – 2013 Update” heading:

Q4. Is there any PCC?

A4. Yes, the City of Ukiah has 0.53 mile of PCC in their network.

Q5. What kinds of base map layer (boundary, center line, lane mile, parcel...) do you have for each agency?

A5. We have street centerline, parcel polygon, and boundary (county/city boundaries) files for all agencies.

Q6. Do you need just linkage of GIS to StreetSaver or design for pavement GIS Layer (match each section to base map) for each agency and linkage with StreetSaver?

A6. GIS Linkage is needed, not layer design. We are using the GIS feature that is part of the StreetSaver program, so any work will be needed in order to make that feature compatible with our updated information.

Q7. Why is difference with total 782 miles and 773 miles of 2016/17 project?

A7. The correct total for the mileage is 782. This was the total mileage in the system at the time of the last update.

Q8. Is wet a signature required on the cover letter?

A8. One original letter with a wet signature is required.

Q9. Section H, page 5 - Methodology for budget – what type of documentation is required? Is an independent audit of our direct labor, fringe benefits and general overhead acceptable?

A9. Yes, an audit is acceptable as long as it describes the methodology and includes all items that make up the fully weighted rate.

Q10. Are there any new roads that need to be added? If so, how many miles are there?

A.10. The County has made a minor addition to their network within one subdivision, totaling less than 1000 feet.

Q11. Can the reports be provided on a thumb drive instead of a CD?

A11. Yes.

Q12. Would MCOG consider the following contract modifications? If so, can we include them as an appendix?

A12. Contract modifications will be addressed during negotiations with the highest ranked proposer.
