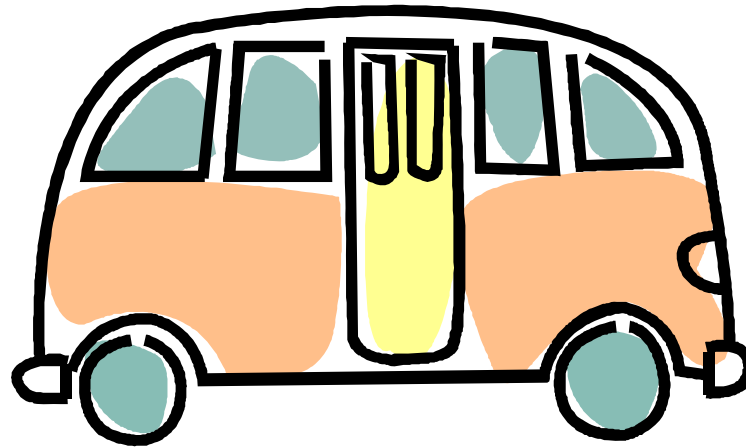

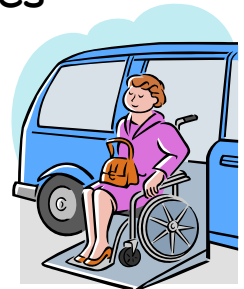

We have seats open on our Social Services Transportation Advisory Council for:

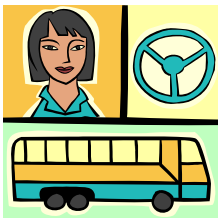
- Potential transit user at least 60 years of age

To All Interested:

Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) currently has two seats open on its Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC), of the nine seats prescribed by state law:

- ❖ Potential transit user at least 60 years of age; and
- ❖ Local social service provider for seniors.

While MCOG prioritizes filling these seats, additional members may be appointed.

The SSTACs were established by the Legislature in 1987 to represent the transit needs of transit-dependent and transit-disadvantaged persons, including the elderly, people with disabilities, and those of limited means. These Councils are organized under the Transportation Development Act (TDA) through the Regional Transportation Planning Agencies (such as MCOG).

The SSTAC is charged with annually reviewing and advising on the adequacy of transportation services and unmet transit needs, as well as advising MCOG on "any other major transit issues." The annual workshop is scheduled for November 7, 2013. Meetings are open to the public and usually held in wheelchair accessible locations. MCOG welcomes participation.
