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NOTICE of PUBLIC HEARING
Unmet Transit Needs

Monday, February 2, 2015, the Mendocino Council of Governments (MCOG) will meet at 1:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, at County Administration Center, Supervisors Chambers, Room 1070, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah, CA, and consider the following item.

MCOG will consider needs for public transportation services that would benefit a significant number of people and are not currently provided. Continued from December 1, 2014, this hearing applies to transportation service needs for fiscal year July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. Issues may include but are not limited to: 1) transit services for the elderly, people with disabilities, and low-income or economically disadvantaged persons; 2) adequacy of both private and public transportation services, and 3) service improvements needed to meet expected travel demand.
